<b>Succeeds in School</b>	Gets mostly As on report card	29	9
<b>Helps Others</b>	Helps friends or neighbors one or more hours per week	82	62
<b>Values Diversity</b>	Places high importance on getting to know people of other racial/ethnic groups	59	29
<b>Maintains Good Health</b>	Pays attention to healthy nutrition and exercise	48	22
<b>Exhibits Leaderships</b>	Has been a leader of a group or organization in the last 12 months	69	45
<b>Resists Danger</b>	Avoids doing things that are dangerous	18	6
<b>Delays Gratification</b>	Saves money for something special rather than spending it all right away	43	23
<b>Overcomes Adversity</b>	Does not give up when things get difficult	72	60
